



CORE MISSION OF THE BUNDESWEHR MEDICAL SERVICE

The primary mission of the Bundeswehr Medical Service is to promote, protect, maintain, and restore the health of military personnel.

The aim is to provide the casualties with the necessary treatment within the defined timelines and to restore the service members' operational readiness in the best and quickest way possible so that they can return to their units as appropriate.

To achieve these goals, the Bundeswehr Medical Service has an interconnected system of medical treatment facilities that feature different capabilities and levels of medical specialty, a land-based and airborne medical evacuation organisation, and a strategic aeromedical evacuation system for moving patients to clinical facilities in Germany.

BACKGROUND

On 24 February 2022, war finally returned to Europe. The peace dividend has been used up, the Bundeswehr must become fit for war again. The Federal Minister of Defence, Boris Pistorius, leaves no doubt about this.

Key element of the armed forces' thinking and action is no longer international crisis management, but national and collective defence. In the future, the Bundeswehr Medical Service shall be able to provide medical support to several divisions and one corps headquarters in high-intensity and highly mobile combat.

The soldiers of the Bundeswehr are not only citizens in uniform, but daughters and sons, sisters and brothers, mothers and fathers. Top-level medical care for servicemen and women is crucial for the acceptance of armed forces in society.

Every day, the war in Ukraine demonstrates anew how important effective and good medical care is for the combat power and sustainability of an army. Current findings show that up to 70% of the personnel replacements in the Ukrainian armed forces are recovered soldiers.

In the event of national and collective defence, Germany will become NATO's central hub in Europe. We must be prepared to receive and care for a large number of wounded, injured and sick patients. This is a whole-of-government task. The Bundeswehr Medical Service will not be able to accomplish this task without the support of civilian relief organisations. ILÜ 24 aims to inform you about the operational doctrine, the capabilities and the capability gaps of the Bundeswehr Medical Service in land operations – from the point of injury to reintegration of service members into the armed forces.

- Learn more about the further evacuation of patients out of the combat area and back to their home countries.
- Discover which innovations can help us to achieve better and better treatment outcomes for our servicemen and women in the future.
